



#### Prime Targets for Human Trafficking

- No support
- Significant financial constraints
- Crucial hopes for PR/Citizenship

- Acknowledgement- Human Trafficking is a significant issue in Brampton amongst International Students
- **Government Lobbying** 
  - **FEDERALLY** → a) **ELIMINATING/CHANGING** Canadian VISA wording (possible deportation if engage in sex trade)
    - b) INCREASING- work cap to more than 24 hours/week
    - c) **IMPROVING** mechanisms to ensure International Students granted entry can afford cost of living
  - PROVINCIAL → MANDITORY- education/awareness programs as a requirement to enroll in post-secondary education
- **Resource/Support Allocation**

#### **CAREFUL SELECTION OF NON-PROFITS that:**

- ① are BEST suited to reach to International Students (similar community → culture, channels, know-how)
- ② low/minimal administration costs thus more goes to this cause
