

MOTION: Bovaird House Discussion item for Special Council Meeting

That the Bovaird House property be managed with existing resources already allocated to manage the Alderlea, another heritage asset owned by the city; and

That staff be directed to explore and implement programming opportunities at the Bovaird House property using existing approved budget, for example: outdoor wedding ceremonies, recreation and sports programming, Culture Days, movie nights, performing arts pop-ups, and more; and

That staff be directed to apply for applicable provincial and federal funding programs to support the programming and/or improvements to the property, especially as it relates to its heritage designation and place in Brampton's history;

That staff continue to explore avenues for the property to achieve museum status, especially considering recent negotiations with the Region of Peel regarding PAMA.

That the Bovaird House property (563 Bovaird Drive East) be declared an official public open space (park) showcasing this historic gem in the city, allowing access for all residents to enjoy while protecting and conserving the character of the buildings and grounds as a historic site

That staff submit any additional requests for resources or programming to the Mayor for consideration during the 2026 budget process.
